- ☐ Index: page nos according to the chapters you will write
- ☐ Chapter 1: **Theory and research** about the main topic of the project
- ☐ Chapter 2: **Theory** about the main topic but in relation to Malta
- □ Chapter 3: **Methodology** describe how you are going to analyse this topic in relation to the Maltese society eg: compiling a questionnaire or an interview

☐ Chapter 4: Data analysis - discuss the outcome of the interview, or each question in detail using bar graphs, piecharts or tables ☐ Chapter 5: Conclusion and recommendations ☐ Chapter 6: Bibliography — include all the books, magazines and internet websites used in alphabetical order □Appendix – attach the questionnaires to this project (these are not included in the wordcount)

Social Studies Titles – choose one of the following

1. Malta: developing into a multicultural society

OR

2. Transitioning from Maltese citizens to a global ones

Malta: developing into a multi-cultural society.

- Research about multiculturalism and about the circumstances and causes that have led to an increasingly multicultural Maltese society.
- Identify ONE effect of multiculturalism on Maltese society and discuss it.
- The project should contain both primary and secondary research.
- The methodology should include a survey/questionnaires to determine current views about multiculturalism in Malta OR interviews with locals, tourists or immigrants.

Transitioning from Maltese citizens to global ones

- Research on how youth today are able to look beyond the confines of the Maltese islands, with the aid of technology and globalisation.
- Focus on how Maltese youths are transitioning from local to global citizens, and analyse the consequences of this phenomenon.
- The project should contain both primary and secondary research.
- The methodology should include a survey/questionnaire exploring this transition to global citizenship OR interviews with locals, tourists, industry professionals etc.
