EQUITY & INCLUSION


This means feeling happy and safe. Feeling good about yourself is important, and we want everyone in school, including your educators, to feel good about themselves and be happy.

### WELLBEING




When children feel happy and safe at school, they do better in their schoolwork and become more respectful. As a result, in the future, children will become good citizens who help their community.
