

Assessment

- **30% School Based Assessment (SBA):**

3 courseworks spread over Year 9, 10 and 11. (10% each)


- **70% Controlled Assessment of 2 hours (Composition from a theme):**

Candidates are given **THREE** Themes, eight weeks before the controlled examination to experiment on at least **ONE** theme. **Research and preparatory work** are to be carried out in **a work journal**. Work created for the journal should be on loose A3 sized sheets. These are to be brought into the examination room and should serve as a starting point from which to develop a new work in colour.

Level 1-2: a minimum of **THREE** to a maximum of **FOUR** sheets are to be presented. From the works candidates present, at least **TWO** should be in full colour.



Level 2-3: a minimum of **FOUR** to a maximum of **FIVE** sheets are to be presented. From the works candidates present, at least **THREE** should be in full colour.


