Choice of Subjects - Option Form

- Choose **one (1)** of the two routes and fill in only one (1) form for the route you have chosen. Fill in your order of preference as explained in the form.

Route 1. Secondary Education Certificate (SEC) Route presents all the SEC academic and vocational subjects. These subjects are certified by MATSEC.

Route 2. APPLIED/SEC Route allows the possibility to choose TWO APPLIED subjects **or** ONE APPLIED and ONE SEC subject.

- Vocational and Applied Subjects** will be available in clusters of schools as shown on Page 4. If a vocational or applied subject is not available in your College, it will be available in another College school within your cluster and you will be able to transfer **full time** to this school. There will be no need to change uniform and transport will be provided. It is very important to ensure that if you choose two (2) vocational or applied subjects, both subjects are available in the school you will attend.
- While every effort will be made to offer all option subjects, this may not always be possible. In that case, students will be offered alternative option subjects.**
- In certain circumstances, students who change College/School may need to make their own arrangements for transport.
- Please return the form to your school by the closing date given to you by your respective school.

- The Secondary Education Certificate (SEC) is run by the MATSEC Board and allows students to achieve up to MQF level 3 in each subject.
- **Students who successfully achieve SEC subjects will be eligible to apply to enter all Post-Secondary Institutions according to the entry requirements of the institution.**

* *SCDP IS AN APPLIED SUBJECT AND IS ACCREDITED BY DQSE. Students cannot choose PE together with SCDP. Eligibility is subject to a 'pass' in the Practical Assessment.*

The sports available differ from one college to another. If the minimum number of successful applicants is not reached, the sport will not be offered.

** *Ethics is only offered at Gozo College, St. Thomas More College, and St. Nicholas College. Only students who keep studying Religious Education in Years 9, 10, and 11 are eligible to choose Ethics as an Option Subject.*

*** *Chinese is only offered at St. Clare's College and St. Margaret's College.*

**** *To choose Computing, students must get at least 35 marks in Mathematics (Track 2 and Track 3 only) and 35 marks in one of the following subjects: Design & Technology, ICT, or Science. The overall marks obtained in Year 7 and Year 8 will be considered.*

***** *Hairdressing and Beauty and Retail Essentials are being offered as applied subjects (AVC) as they will not be offered as vocational (VET) subjects by MATSEC in 2027. These subjects are accredited by DQSE.*

- The Applied Vocational Certificate (AVC) subjects focus on a more practical hands-on approach. They are accredited by DQSE.
- The Secondary Education Certificate (SEC) subjects are accredited by the MATSEC Board.
- AVC and SEC subjects allow students to achieve up to MQF level 3.
- Students who successfully achieve AVC subjects can currently use them as entry requirements to MCAST, ITS, GCHSS and SMARSF. AT GCHSS and SMARSF subjects must be at level 3.
- Students who successfully achieve SEC subjects can use them as entry requirements to all Post-Secondary Institutions.
