## Summer Catch-Up Classes 2026 - Students Call for Application

### Overview

The Summer Catch-Up Programme 2026 is designed to support students who may need additional help with their studies, as well as those who wish to revise and feel more confident and at ease at school. The programme is open to all students from Year 1 to Year 10.

This initiative provides targeted revision of material covered during the previous scholastic year. Lessons will be delivered in small year-group settings by fully qualified teachers, covering both primary and secondary levels. The programme shall be running for eight weeks between July 13<sup>th</sup> and September 3<sup>rd</sup> on a four-day week.

### What you'll get

The Summer Catch-Up Programme 2026 is an in-person and online initiative designed to support students from Year 1 to Year 10 with revision and academic confidence-building.

#### Programme Duration

- **Dates:** Monday, 13th July – Thursday, 3rd September 2026
- **Schedule:** Mondays to Thursdays for 8 consecutive weeks

- Applications are accepted on a first-come, first-served basis
- Once classes are full, students will be placed on a waiting list and contacted as soon as a place becomes available

- Each application is evaluated on its individual merits, with reference to the student's IEP and any relevant input.
- Any decision to refuse an application will be supported by a written justification that is specific to the individual case
