



## COLLECTION OF BOOKS – YEAR 10 STUDENTS

Students in Year 10 during Scholastic Year 2025-2026 are to return all textbooks on **MONDAY 15th JUNE 2026**, and consult the **TIME** listed below.

Please note the following points:

- No books will be accepted if not on the day listed.
- Lost, soiled or torn books are to be **PAID** for on the day of collection.
- Students who fail to return a book/s will not get their annual results published on MySchool.
- Kindly return the books **in the order listed**. This is especially important so as not to waste unnecessary time.
- Books must be returned **personally** at the scheduled time. If you are unavailable, a family member may bring them, provided you notify your Deputy Head of School beforehand.
- It is important to wear your summer school uniform. Students not wearing their uniform will be stopped by the security officer and considered as not having returned any textbooks.
- Returned books are not to be left with the security officer or dropped off at the block's entrance but taken directly to the second floor in **Block 2**, whereby students are to wait their turn and the librarians will check each book.
